

Use of Cookies on enjoycubaexperience.com

A cookie is a small file installed by a website on a user's device. This file stores the internet parameters of the connection device and information relating to the user's browsing.

When you connect to the website again using the same device, the browser can use the cookie data and transmit it to the website after verification. Cookies are important for the proper functioning of a website, as they allow you to store connection information, provide a secure connection, collect statistics in order to optimize the functionality of the website and adapt the content to your interests.

In order to enhance your experience on enjoycubaexperience.com, when you view our website or emails, we may set cookies on your browser. **Functional** cookies provide additional features that are of interest to you. **Internal personalization** cookies allow us to measure content to tailor it to your tastes. **External** (third party) **personalization** cookies allow us to present you with personalized advertisements outside of enjoycubaexperience.com.

Cookies are used to personalise the content we offer you; adapt the presentation of our web pages to the display preferences of your device, hardware, display or reading programs on your device; save information relating to a form you have filled in on our website, for example, when requesting a quote; save the products, services or information you have chosen; individually measure the use made of mass mailings of e-mails.

The information stored in the cookies we use is anonymous and can only be read in the context of the operations of Skedio, SL. You can partially or totally oppose the installation of cookies on your device. However, this choice is likely to modify your Internet browsing and substantially alter some access to our services and publications that require the reading of cookies installed.

There are several types of cookies:

- Session cookies that facilitate browsing, are stored on the connection device (PC, laptop, tablet or mobile phone) at the time of the visit to a website (the session), are only active when browsing the site and are deleted after closing the browser.
- Persistent cookies that remain on your device until they expire or until you delete them from your browser cache and they become active.

each time you visit the website that created them. They allow us to recognise you, help us to analyse your behaviour on the website and identify problems. All information is collected anonymously.

- User authentication cookies that allow registered members who wish to log in to your account not to need a password.
- Shopping cart cookies that allow the use of the main functionalities of access to an account or a shopping cart and facilitate navigation.
- Analytical cookies that serve to analyze the audience of a website allowing to know the frequency of visits, the use of the site and measure its performance. They allow to improve the performance and usability of websites highlighting some content with greater demand and simplifying navigation.
- Advertising cookies, which collect your areas of interest, which will then be used to present you with communications tailored to your tastes or needs, even after you have left the website. You can refuse advertising cookies. Rejecting advertising cookies does not affect the way a website works and does not prevent advertising content from being displayed. The advertising content will still be displayed, but without taking into account your preferences and interests.
- Third-party cookies, from partner companies, to enhance the value of our audience, it is possible that these partners install cookies on the connected device. Some cookies may have been issued by external services used on our website for web analytics and queries, recognition of your device for communications tailored to your areas of interest and sharing content on social networks.
- Social media cookies: when you use the buttons to share content online via social networks such as Twitter and Facebook, a *cookie* will be set on your device's browser.

5. Controlling and deleting cookies

You can refuse the installation of these cookies on your device by modifying the settings relating to cookies through the browser management interface. You can also choose to configure your browser so that it asks you each time you want to store a *cookie* or delete cookies stored by the browser on your connection device.

The processes for controlling and deleting cookies differ depending on the browser software and we suggest you use the "Help" function of your browser for more information.

Cookie management guide for the main browsers:

- Internet Explorer 6, 7 or 8 (Microsoft): choose Tools, Internet Options, Privacy, and select the desired level.
- Internet Explorer 9: select Tools, then Internet Options, then Privacy, then Settings and scroll to your preferences before clicking OK.
- Firefox: choose from the Preferences menu, Privacy and your preferred settings.
- Netscape 6.X and 7. X: choose in the menu Edit, Preferences, Confidentiality and Security and then Cookies.
- Opera 6.0 and later: choose File, Preferences and then Privacy.
- Chrome: click on the menu and choose Settings, then Settings Advanced, Privacy & Security, Website Settings and then under Cookies select the level you want.
- Safari: Click the Preferences menu and then click Privacy to choose. At any time, you can delete cookies already installed on your computer or mobile device.
